CPEP Notes, 1/17/2017

- 1. Director's Update: CPEP Sites
 - Rob reports: Not much has changed since the last board meeting regarding Auburn's funding status; "Lynn O." will be at Auburn in place of David Roth
 - Cayuga's Dep. of Programs will be moving to Auburn.
 - Five Points has excluded any volunteer under the age of 21; these volunteers will be reabsorbed into the classes at Auburn
 - Rob assures us that Auburn will continue offering classes into next Fall, that funding will figure itself out
- 2. <u>CPEP Board Leadership</u>
 - a. <u>New faculty director election</u>
 - Faculty Director (F.D.) position must be filled: Sam is willing to continue for another year-long interim term, or a full 2-year term, unless others are interested
 - Eligible F.D.'s must technically be tenured, unretired professors, though due to time constraints, such people pragmatically would have a hard time fulfilling the F.D. role. Sam will reach out to the eligible current board members: Bob, Bruce, Tom, Peter, and Deb.
 - Sandra Greene expressed interest in F.D. position after her Chair position is up

b. Membership and attendance requirements

- Willie proposes that we should consider revising the CPEP Charter, since it was written at a time when our program needed such stability
- Rob proposes 3-year terms and at least a 1-year hiatus (also suggests we can nominate board members and specific positions on the email list), and Ken proposes a 3-year term for the Faculty Director. 3-year terms for regular members is approved.
- We will officially nominate new members and sort out 3-year terms at our next board meeting.

3. <u>CPEP Meeting Schedule</u>

a. <u>Frequency of meetings</u>

- Some propose meeting once a semester. We take a vote on 1 meeting/semester plus a social event (ala the Big Red Barn event from December): we vote in favor 7-1 (Sam is the outlier).

b. Meeting attendance requirements

- Sam proposes "no attendance = no membership on the board". There is not much support for this initially. No official vote.
- Ray directs us to a provision in the Charter: should all members be on a committee? No official vote.
- We agree that as long as members are actively participating and contributing toward CPEP, they can remain on the board.
- To address next board meeting: beginning committees to address technology at Five Points as well as bringing in dogs to a facility

- Rob will email Chris and Julily to confirm whether they will remain on the board.
- 4. <u>Upcoming interviews</u>: Reminder that two job candidates are visiting this week.
- 5. Empire State College Pilot Program
 - M.O.U. sent by Empire: this has the potential to derail the program
 - Mercy College and Nyack College are offering a B.A. for Associates graduates this is possible route for CPEP graduates who have time remaining on their sentences
