Draft CPEP Reentry Policy Proposal Outline

§1: Distinguishing among college-enrolled returning citizens

"new to college" <30 credit hours
"some college" ≥30 credit hours
AA graduate AA degree

• transfer student from another college-in-prison program

- §2: CPEP currently endeavors to work with students with "some college" or an AA degree. CPEP also works with people who are "new to college" who show exceptional persistence and commitment to continue their education. What CPEP does:
 - Pre-release consultation and needs analysis
 - Documentation of initial experience of return, and subsequent milestones
 - Referrals to social service agencies
 - Coordinate letters of recommendation
 - Assist with college applications, FAFSA, etc.
 - Occasional networking events hosted throughout the year in Ithaca and NYC

§3: What CPEP doesn't do:

- Connect active, in-prison DOCCS volunteers with newly paroled CPEP students
- Direct provisioning of social services
- Directly paying, employing, or enrolling students via Cornell




Figure 1: Map of the geographic distribution of the only 18 CPEP students who completed one "full year of college" (≥30 college credits) who had been paroled as of July 1, 2017.
