How to get to the Graduate Roosevelt

- 1) F train: Click here to see the entire F train line. Costs \$2.75 and comes approximately every 7 to 10 minutes
- From the last stop in Queens (Jamaica 179th Street Station) it'll take 45 minutes to an hour to get to Roosevelt Island.
- From the last stop in Brooklyn (Coney Island Stillwell Avenue Station) it'll take 75 to 90 minutes to get to Roosevelt Island.
- From the last stop in Manhattan (East Broadway Station) going towards Uptown and Queens it'll take under 30 minutes to get to Roosevelt Island.
- 2) By Car: The Graduate Roosevelt is fully accessible by car. You can enter Roosevelt Island via the Roosevelt Island Bridge located in Astoria on Vernon Boulevard and 36th avenue. There is paid meter parking as well as a valet. Our price for Valet is \$45 up to 4 hours and anything over 4 hours is \$65. All payments will be done directly with the front desk. 3) Roosevelt Island Tram: entrance located at 59th Street and Second Avenue to Tramway Plaza on Roosevelt Island. Pricing is the same as MTA fares. (currently \$2.75). The Tram comes every 7 to 15 minutes. Hours of Operations: Sunday through Thursday: 6 AM - 2 AM & Friday and Saturday: 6 AM - 3:30 AM. Click here for more information.



4) Q102 MTA Bus: if you are coming to Roosevelt Island from the Astoria area the Q102 bus takes around 30-40 minutes from the first stop in Astoria (27th avenue & 2nd street). Click here to find the real time locations of buses on route plus all bus stops. Cost \$2.75 and comes approximately every 15 minutes. (Bus route map below Q102 in Navy)



5) Ferry: The Astoria Ferry goes directly into Roosevelt Island. This Ferry Line stops at Wall Street/Pier 11, Brooklyn Navy Yard, East 34th Street, Long Island City Gantry Plaza, Roosevelt Island, Astoria, & East 90th street. Costs \$2.75 for a one way trip.
